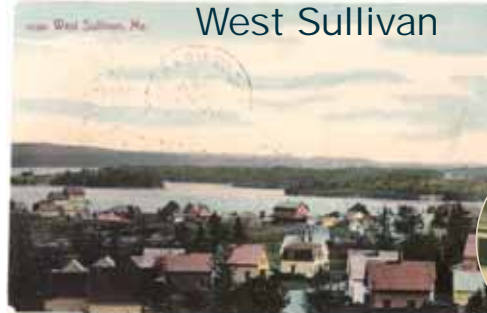

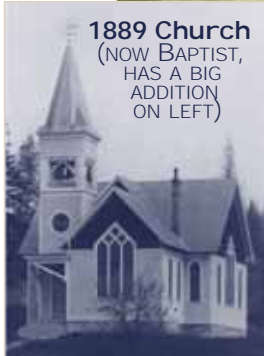

1889 Church (NOW BAPTIST, HAS A BIG ADDITION ON LEFT)



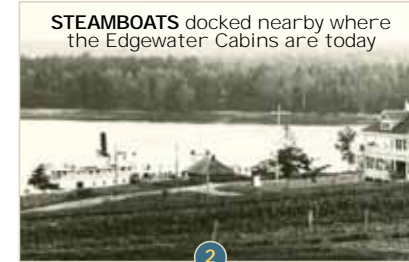
